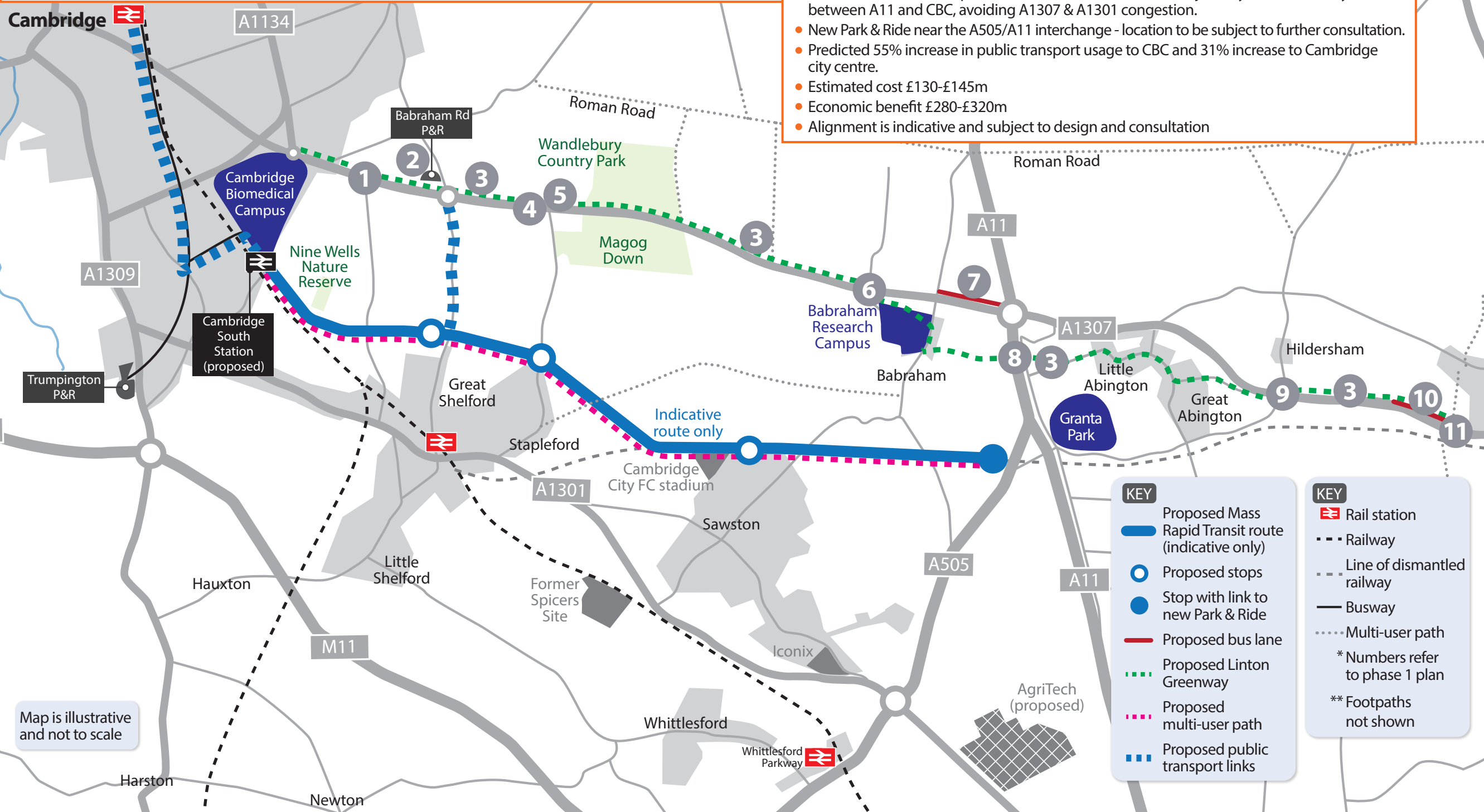


Strategy 1 – Mass Rapid Transit Route

A new dedicated Mass Rapid Transit route between the A11 and the Cambridge Biomedical Campus via Sawston, Stapleford, Great Shelford with onward connection to the city centre. It would partly follow the route of the dismantled railway line. The multi-user path alongside the proposed transport route could form part of the Sawston Greenway.

Cambridge rail station (via Busway) CBC A11

- 8km dedicated Mass Rapid Transit route would offer reliable journey times (two-way) between A11 and CBC, avoiding A1307 & A1301 congestion.
- New Park & Ride near the A505/A11 interchange - location to be subject to further consultation.
- Predicted 55% increase in public transport usage to CBC and 31% increase to Cambridge city centre.
- Estimated cost £130-£145m
- Economic benefit £280-£320m
- Alignment is indicative and subject to design and consultation
