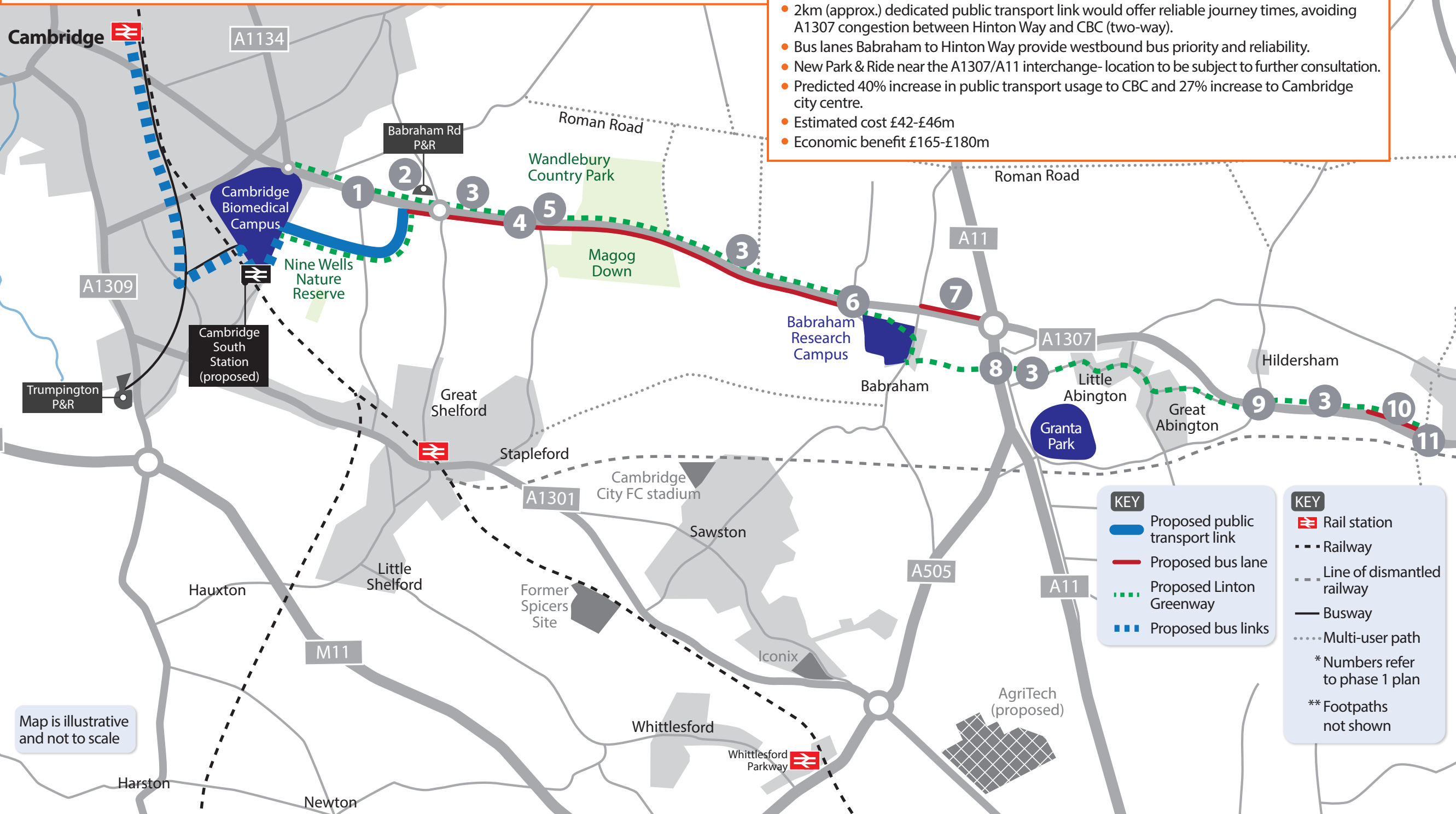


Strategy 2 – Bus Lanes along A1307 & Public Transport Link to CBC

An inbound bus lane from Babraham Research Campus to Babraham Road Park & Ride and a new dedicated public transport link between the Park & Ride and Cambridge Biomedical Campus, with onward connection to the city centre.

Cambridge rail station (via Busway) CBC A11

- 2km (approx.) dedicated public transport link would offer reliable journey times, avoiding A1307 congestion between Hinton Way and CBC (two-way).
- Bus lanes Babraham to Hinton Way provide westbound bus priority and reliability.
- New Park & Ride near the A1307/A11 interchange- location to be subject to further consultation.
- Predicted 40% increase in public transport usage to CBC and 27% increase to Cambridge city centre.
- Estimated cost £42-£46m
- Economic benefit £165-£180m
