ABOUT THE SCHEME

The Cambridge South West Travel Hub will provide;

- Around 2,250 car parking spaces
- Around 80 Velobox cycle parking spaces, plus conventional cycle parking.
- A new long-distance coach hub
- Public transport routes to Cambridge and the Biomedical Campus

The proposals will;

- Provide additional access to public transport, catering for new jobs and houses in the area
- Help to relieve the Park & Ride site at Trumpington, which is already over capacity
- Ease congestion on routes into Cambridge by making it easier to travel by public transport.
